DURATION

Duration of the programme shall be four years (Eight semesters). Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester from Semester I to VII. Semester VIII is the period of internship intended for intensive practicum/residency posting.

I.INTRODUCTION

1.1 Overview of the B.Sc Nursing Course

VNSS College of Nursing offer B.Sc Nursing Degree programme of 4 year duration distributed in 8 semesters as specified by Kerala University of Health

Sciences,(KUHS),approved by Indian Nursing Council & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

- 1.2 VNSS College of Nursing is the professional Educational Institution under SNTMM has decided to introduce a unified selection procedure for admission of candidates in the management quota to the B.Sc Nursing course as per the direction of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in its judgments dated 31st October 2002,dated 14th August 2003 and 4th January 2007
- 1.3 This prospectus contains the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the seats to be filled by the Managements of VNSS College of Nursing, Kollam,for the year 2022-23
- 1.4 This Prospectus is subject to modification /addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by college authorities subject to the judgments of Honorable Courts of Law.

Number of Seats

2.1.No.of seats -60 ,Merit quota - 30 (allotted by LBS)
Management quota- 30

2.2 a) All the candidates admitted shall pay the fees fixed by Government of Kerala/Fee Regulatory Committee and as approved or modified by competent authorities.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

UNIFORM

- Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the College during clinical experience.
- Students should have their hair put up and should wear prescribed footwear only, during clinical experience.
- Students are not allowed to wear any jewelry except small earrings during the clinical experience.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES

- Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college. Students are encouraged to become members of the Student Nurses Association. The Student Nurses Association will provide a means of personal and professional development for the nursing student.
- To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.
- Educational trips are arranged for the students every year. Educational trips will be charged during the course and students will have to bear the full expense of the trip.

CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- Students are responsible to the Principal for the behavior both in and outside the college.
- Students should maintain silence in the class, library and in the corridors when lectures are in session.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college, hostel and hospital property.
- Any willful damage done to the property of the college, hostel and hospital will be dealt with as a breach of discipline.
- Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the hospital, and college authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviors.
- Students who are found to have major health problems and unable to continue the course viz., cardiac problems, epilepsy, tuberculosis, infectious skin diseases, psychiatric problems or any other major illness will have to discontinue their course and the fees paid will not be refunded.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

Each student will undergo an annual medical checkup. Students will be immunized against infectious diseases as and when necessary. If illness occurs during their course they will be cared for in the hospital on payment.

HOSTEL

Hostel facilities will be provided only to the girls.

III. Eligibility for Admission

3.1 Academic:-

- (i) Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with Aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 50% marks in English in second year only are eligible for admission
- (ii) Candidate should be Medically fit and should not have any physical- Mental handicap

Relaxation in marks:

Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with total annual family income up to RS 6 lakhs will have relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates in the state of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination for submitting the application.

- Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management Quota.
- **Eligibility Certificates:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and eligibility of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission

3.2 Age :

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2021. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.

IV How to apply

- A candidate who seeks admission to the VNSS College of Nursing, Kollam, under the management quota should submit an online application in the website of the college www.vnsscon.com. Hard copy also to be submitted or send to the college office.
- Application fee is Rs.600/- has to be remitted through demand draft drawn in favor of Chairman, VNSS College of Nursing, Kollam. Details of DD should be uploaded. Original DD has to be submitted or send to the Principal, VNSS College of Nursing, Kollam -1 along with other documents
- Along with the application form the following should be uploaded
 - Passport size photograph of candidate taken after 01.01.2022
 - Copy of SSLC Certificate (proof of date of birth & caste)
 - Marklist of qualifying examination (plus one and plus two)
 - Print out of the application form

V. Preparation of Merit List

5.1 Merit List

Out of 60 seats 35% seats will be filled by managements from among the applications received on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in (+2) in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria.

5.2.NRI Quota

- 15% NRI seats shall be filled up from qualified students as per G.O (MS) No.243/2014/HRFWD dated 06.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala. The original documents shall be submitted at the time of admission. Documents required for NRI quota are :

- 1) Sponsorship Certificate
- 2) The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped
- 3) Employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy
- 4) Relationship Certificate from the village Officer /Tahasildar
- 5) Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Got.order No. GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd 22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/KUHS/2014,dated 12.06.2014

5.3 Resolution of tie while ranking:

In the case of tie in the total marks, the marks in Biology will count. If there is still a tie the marks in chemistry & Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken in to account, the elder will be preferred than younger.

5.4 Inclusion in the merit list will not entitle the applicant eligible for admission to the course, unless the applicant satisfy the rules regarding the eligibility for admission and other conditions as laid down in the prospectus.

5.5 Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of land.

According to the Fee Structure prescribed for the NRI category seats in AFRC Order no. AFRC50/18/B.Sc(N) dated 10.05.2018, the Annual Tuition Fees payable by students being admitted under the NRI category seats is Rs.95,000/-per year. All other fees including special fees as detailed above of this prospectus are applicable to students admitted under the NRI category.

6.2 All other fees due to statutory bodies (KUHS, KNMC & INC) as and when notified later by the government.

6.3 If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, The candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course (4 Year). The collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the AFRC of court of law.

VII. Special Instructions.

- (i) Ragging : Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in college, hostel and premises. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regards.
- (ii) Use of Mobile Phone: Use of mobile phone by students is not allowed in the classes
- (iii) Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the admission authority

VIII Selection

8.1 Selection of the candidates will be purely based on merit according to the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

A provisional ranklist will be prepared and published in the website on 22.08.2022. The date of admission will be informed **through** online.

8.2 Candidates should bring the following documents in original for verification at the time of admission

- 2) Allotment Memo
- 3) Aadhar Card
- 4) SSLC Certificate
- 5) Marklist of qualifying examination
- 6) Certificate in proof of OBC/SC/ST status if applicable
- 7) Course certificate and Conduct certificate
- 8) Transfer Certificate
- 9) Migration Certificate (if needed)
- 10) Medical fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner having MBBS or higher qualification
- 11) Ten passport size Photo
- 12) Eligibility Certificate issued by KUHS(other states candidate)
- 13) Undertaking regarding non –involvement in ragging
- 14) Two sets of photocopies of documents from 1 to 8 in the list

It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that the qualifying examination he/she has passed is recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences as eligible qualification for admission


